





By letter dated March 31, 1982, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator of the Lindrith Unit, filed a Drilling Program covering the subject Unit for the calendar year 1982 providing for the drilling of four (4) Pictured Cliffs wells (#105, #109, #110, #111). All wells were drilled outside the Pictured Cliffs Participating Area and are currently being tested to determine whether each will be commercial thereby causing an expansion.






