



The schedules attached as Exhibits "3", "4" and "5" describe the lands within each proposed area or area enlargement. Also reflected is each lease within each area and its percentage of the total participating area. Please note that we have attached justification for each well to be allocated approximately 160 acres, following an established drainage pattern for the Fruitland Formation wells. Inasmuch as the #344 and #347 are separate pools from previously completed Fruitland Formation wells, we have designated the new "E" and "F" Fruitland areas.

We have no problems with the effective date of each area being the first of the month following the date information was received in order to justify the establishment of the participating areas as required by the unit agreement. Further, we note that the two wells expanding the Fruitland "C" were completed in different months, but since there have been no production sales on either well prior to May 1, 1985, we have chosen the later effective date for the enlargement and include both wells as the second enlargement.
