





By letter dated February 10, 1975, Northwest Pipeline, Unit Operator, filed a Drilling Program for the calendar year 1975 providing for the drilling of one test well.

Northwest Pipeline Corporation has contacted the Working Interest Owners and has received the necessary concurrence to propose the drilling of the following additional wells during 1975:







By letter dated January 23, 1974, El Paso Natural Gas Company, then Unit Operator of the captioned Unit, filed a drilling program for the calendar year 1974 providing for no wells. 



Pertinent data on this well is as follows:

The San Juan 32-7 Unit #25 Well, located 795' from the north line and 1680' from the east line of Section 36, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, N.M.P.M., was spudded July 31, 1974, and completed on August 14, 1974 at a total depth of 5890'. The Mesaverde Formation in the intervals between 5570'-5578'; 5588'-5596'; 5676'-5684'; 5720'-5728'; 5738'-5746'; 5756'-5772'; and 5805'-5824' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on August 14, 1974. The well was shut-in on August 16, 1974, and after being shut-in for the seven (7) days the Mesaverde Formation was tested on August 23, 1974, and after a three-hour blow down period the well gauged 3958 MCF/d through a 3/4 inch choke and 5920 MCF/d by the calculated absolute open-flow method, with a SIPC of 1218 psia and a SIPT of 1218 psia. The determination that this well is capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Mesaverde Formation was made on August 23, 1974.

The San Juan 32-7 Unit #26 Well, located 1060' from the north line and 950' from the east line of Section 35, Township 32 North, Range 7 West, N.M.P.M., was spudded August 15, 1974, and completed on August 28, 1974 at a total depth of 6160'. The Mesaverde Formation in the intervals between 5836'-5848'; 5860'-5868'; 5886'-5898'; 5984'-6000'; and 6012'-6036' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on August 28, 1974.

The well was shut-in on August 29, 1974, and after being shut-in for seven (7) days the Mesaverde Formation was tested on September 6, 1974, and after a three-hour blow down period the well gauged 2511 MCF/d through a 3/4 inch choke and 3178 MCF/d by the calculated absolute open-flow method, with a SIPC of 1115 psia and a SIPT of 1036 psia. The determination that this well is capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Mesaverde Formation was made on September 6, 1974.

Gentlemen:

On June 16, 1972, the United States District Court for the District of Colorado, in Civil Action C-2626, ordered that certain assets and properties of El Paso Natural Gas Company ("El Paso") be divested to Northwest Pipeline Corporation ("Northwest"). This order was affirmed by the United States Supreme Court on March 5, 1973. On September 21, 1973, the Federal Power Commission issued an order authorizing Northwest to acquire and operate the assets and properties to be divested and recognizing Northwest as successor to El Paso's interests in these assets. On October 19, 1973, the District Court entered its final order directing that the divestiture be completed forthwith. The properties and assets consist primarily of El Paso's Northwest Division gas system, much of which was formerly owned by Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation.

Among the properties to be divested are those lands in the captioned Unit which El Paso acquired from Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation. In conjunction with this divestment El Paso wishes to resign as Unit Operator and Northwest wishes to succeed El Paso as Unit Operator. Upon obtaining working interest owner consent Northwest will request to be approved by the Director and the Commissioner as Successor Unit Operator.

While neither El Paso nor Northwest is certain as to specifically when Northwest will be able to replace El Paso as Unit Operator, we are both hopeful that this can be accomplished within from 60 to 90 days. For
