Pursuant to Section 11(a) of the San Juan 27-5 Unit Agreement, #14-08-001-950, approved August 31, 1953, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator, determined on the dates set out below that two (2) additional wells capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Pictured Cliffs formation have been completed upon acreage committed to the Unit. These wells are as follows:

The San Juan 27-5 Unit #60A Well, located 1770' from the South line and 1610' from the East line of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., was spudded on October 3, 1979, and completed on May 21, 1980, at a plugged back depth of 6035'. The Pictured Cliffs formation at the selected intervals between 3430' and 3494' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on April 12, 1980. The well was shut-in on May 6, 1980,

and after being shut-in for fifteen (15) days, the Pictured Cliffs formation was tested on May 21, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 1324 MCF/D, with an SIPC of 1080 psia and an SIPT of 1089 psia. The Mesaverde formation at the selected intervals between 5107' and 5961' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on April 12, 1980. The well was shut-in on May 6, 1980, and after being shut-in for seven (7) days, the Mesaverde formation was tested on May 13, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 4912 MCF/D, with an SIPT of 873 psia. The spacing unit for this well is described as the E/2 of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., containing 319.69 acres.

The San Juan 27-5 Unit #21A Well, located 1800' from the South line and 810' from the East line of Section 3, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., was spudded on October 13, 1979, and completed on July 3, 1980, at a plugged back depth of 6156'. The Pictured Cliffs formation at the selected intervals between 3535' and 3582' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on April 21, 1980. The well was shut-in on June 23, 1980, and after being shut-in for ten (10) days, the Pictured Cliffs formation was tested on July 3, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 1756 MCF/D, with an SIPC of 1080 psia and an SIPT of 1088 psia. The Mesaverde formation at the selected intervals between 5214' and 6000' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on April 20, 1980. The well was shut-in on June 22, 1980, and after being shut-in for one (1) day, the Mesaverde formation was tested on June 23, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 4069 MCF/D, with an SIPT of 1000 psia. The spacing unit for this well is described as the E/2 of Section 3, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., containing 319.16 acres.

The drilling blocks for the #60A well is included in the San Juan 27-5 Unit Twenty-Fifth Expanded Participating Area of the Pictured Cliffs formation, effective June 1, 1980. The drilling block for the #21A well is included in the San Juan 27-5 Unit Twenty-Sixth Expanded Participating Area of the Pictured Cliffs formation, effective August 1, 1980. The Mesaverde formations of both of the above wells have been completed on acreage already in the existing Mesaverde Participating Area. The completion of these wells do not warrant any further expansion of the Mesaverde Participating Area.

In addition to the above, the completion of the #21A well creates two (2) intervening drilling blocks described as the E/2 of Section 10, T-27-N, R-5-W, and the W/2 of Section 3, T-27-N, R-5-W, which pursuant to the terms of the Unit Agreement must also be admitted to the Participating Area.

Attached hereto are Schedules XXVI and XXVII showing the Twenty-Fifth and Twenty-Sixth Expanded Participating Areas for the Pictured Cliffs formation in the San Juan 27-5 Unit Area. These Schedules describe the Expanded Participating Areas, shows the percentage of unitized substances allocated to

each unitized tract, and the exact breakdown of percentages allocated to each tract according to the various ownerships in said tract. Inasmuch as this needs no official approval, no provision is made therefor, and in the absence of disapproval, these Expanded Participating Areas will become effective as of June 1, 1980 and August 1, 1980 respectively.



Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Section 11(a) of the San Juan 27-5 Unit Agreement, #14-08-001-950, approved August 31, 1953, El Paso Natural Gas Company, as Unit Operator, determined on the date set out below that two (2) additional wells capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities from the Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde Formations have been completed upon acreage committed to the Unit. These wells are as follows:

The San Juan 27-5 Unit #61A Well, located 1503' from the South line and 820' from the East line of Section 5, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., was spudded on September 9, 1979, and completed on May 5, 1980, at a plugged back depth of 6094'. The Pictured Cliffs Formation at the selected intervals between 3506' and 3562' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on March 30, 1980. The well was shut-in on April 28, 1980, and after being shut-in for seven (7) days, the Pictured Cliffs Formation was tested on May 5, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac quage of 757 MCF/D, with an SIPC of 1050 psia and an SIPT of 1050 psia. The Mesaverde Formation at the selected intervals between 5719' and 6050' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on March 30, 1980. The well was shut-in on April 5, 1980, and after being shut-in for twenty-three (23) days, the Mesaverde Formation was tested on April 28, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 3722 MCF/D, with an SIPT of 739 psia. The spacing unit for this well is described as the E/2 of Section 5, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., containing 320.77 acres.

The San Juan 27-5 Unit #64A Well, located 810' from the North line and 810' from the West line of Section 9, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., was spudded on September 22, 1979, and completed on May 8, 1980, at a plugged back depth of 6176'. The Pictured Cliffs Formation at the selected intervals between 3564' and 3630' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on April 7, 1980. The well was shut-in on May 1, 1980, and after being shut-in for seven (7) days, the Pictured Cliffs Formation was tested on May 8, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac guage of 954 MCF/D, with an SIPC of 1073 psia and an SIPT of 1070 psia. The Mesaverde Formation at the selected intervals between 5236' and 6069' was treated with a sand-water fracturing process on April 7, 1980. The well was shut-in on April 24, 1980, and after being shut-in for seven (7) days, the Mesaverde Formation was tested on May 1, 1980, using the Pitot tube method with an after frac quage of 2469 MCF/D, with an SIPT of 597 psia. The spacing unit for this well is described as the W/2 of Section 9, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., containing 320.00 acres.

Both of the drilling blocks for the above-described wells are included within the existing Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde Participating Areas; therefore, the Pictured Cliffs and Mesaverde Participating Areas are not enlarged by these wells.


