Gentiemen:

The State Land Office records reflect that under Paragraph 6 of the Villiams Agreement, which was approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands April 14. 1955, a first test well was spudded April 29, 1955, and, according to the Cil Conservation Commission Form No. C-103, this well was plugged and abendoned December 20, 1955. Paragraph 8 of the Williams Agreement provides "... Until a discovery of a deposit of unitied substances capable of being produced in paying quantities, Unit Operator shall continue drilling diligently one well at a time allowing not more than six menths between the completion of one well and the beginning of the next well until a well capable of producing unitied substances in paying quantities is completed to the satisfaction of the Commissioner, ..."

Therefore, the second test well should have been spudded, since no extension was given nor requested, six months after the plugging date of the first well, which was June 20, 1956.

Its being apparent from your letter of june 26, 1956, that you as Operator and the above listed joinders of this Unit wish this Unit terminated under its own terms.

Therefore, the Commissioner of Public Lands agrees to such termination and declares such Unit terminated as of June 20, 1956, and the State Land Office records will so reflect.

Dear Mr. Walker:

I wanted to give you a progress report on our Lucas & Aston
East Hoswell Unit State #1 Well.

This well was drilled to a depth of 135' with 16" hole and on Monday February 28, 135' of 13 3/8" casing was set and cemented with 37 sacks of cement.

Mr. T. M. Thornton, who had contracted to drill the surface hole, has moved out during shut-down time for cementing and Mr. A. J. Smith of Smith Drilling Company has moved the large Wichita Falls spudder in and will commence drilling following completion of cementing shut-down.

I will submit a form C-103 showing the result of casing shut-off.
