Gentlemen:

In connection with the above unit, we hand you herewith two copies each of revised Exhibit "B" to the Unit Agreement, and revised Exhibit "C" to the Unit Operating Agreement; these revisions are effective August 1, 1959.

Please be advised that pursuant to an appropriate Ratification and Joinder with appropriate Consents to Subsequent Joinder coupled with the approval thereof by the Commissioner on July 27, 1959 and the Certificate of Approval by the Director of the Geological Survey, that the above unit has been expanded to embrace the $E^1_2SE^1_4$, $SE^1_4NE^1_4$ Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M.; said lands are embraced in United States Oil and Gas Lease LC 069184. This Subsequent Joinder is effective August 1, 1959 pursuant to the last sentence of Article 31 of the Unit Agreement.

Duplicate counterparts of the aforementioned Ratification and Joinder and Consents thereto are enclosed. We have not yet received the Certificate of Approval by the Director (although we know that it has been executed), but these will be submitted in the immediate future.

PROGRESS REPORT NO. 1

The North Central Caprock Queen Unit became effective at 7:00 a.m., January 1, 1959. A gauge was taken of the merchantable oil in storage on the morning of January 1, 1959. At the same time the temperature of the oil and the BS&W content was measured. Affidavits were prepared by Great Western Drilling Company showing the legal amount of oil in storage on the effective date of the Unit. All these affidavits have been signed by the former operators and forwarded to the purchasers.

Unit production for the month of January totaled 6745.35 barrels oil. The oil in storage on the first of January was 3533.77 barrels. Pipe line runs of 5609.42 barrels during January leave 4669.63 barrels oil in storage at the end of the month.

Construction of the injection plant is proceeding as anticipated. All of the necessary equipment has been ordered and is nearly all scheduled to arrive in February. The foundation for the injection plant building has been poured and is ready to set the triplex pump and allied equipment. The building will be constructed in early February. The water supply line is on location and ready to be installed as soon as all the bids from dirt contractors are in. The pipe line right of way has been obtained from the land owners and the State. Various necessary roads have been built as have the tank grades. The water storage tanks have arrived and are ready to be constructed. Various other items and miscellaneous material are at the Unit site and we anticipate no trouble in obtaining all the necessary material at the proper time.





In connection with the above Order of December 17 involving the North Central Caprock Queen Unit, and in compliance with paragraph 6, page 5 thereof, we hand you herewith one fully executed counterpart of the North Central Caprock Queen Unit Agreement with the Certificate of Approval thereof by the Commissioner of Public Lands dated December 22, 1958.

You are advised that those portions of the unit area lying in Section 15, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, and owned by the United States of America with Whaley Company as operator, have not yet been committed to the unit; as a consequence, the enclosed unit agreement has not been signed by Whaley Company, nor approved by the U.S.G.S. It is hoped that pursuant to Article 31 of the unit agreement that the federal lands will be committed to the unit agreement at an early date, and in compliance with paragraph 7, page 5, of the above Order, we will submit to the Commission an executed counterpart of all instruments subscribed, ratified or approved by the parties so committing the federal acreage. We thank you for your telegram opinion of December 22 concerning approval of the U.S.G.S. as applicable to the federal acreage only, and we agree with you in your conclusions therein reached.

Lastly, for your information, Article 23 provides that the unit agreement shall become effective upon the first day of the next month following the subscription, approval and recording; on this latter point, the unit agreement was filed in Chaves County on December 23 and in Lea County on December 24. It would therefore appear to us that the North Central Caprock Queen Unit Agreement is effective as of January 1, 1959.

If further matters are desired of us, please advise.

WHEREAS, a Unit Agreement for the Development and Operation of the North Central Caprock Queen Unit in Lea and Chaves Counties, New Mexico, was made and entered into by and between certain parties subscribing, ratifying or consenting thereto by an Agreement dated the 2nd day of September, 1958, which, pursuant to Article 23 thereof, was effective January 1, 1959; and,

WHEREAS, Tract No. 30 of the Unit Area described in said Agreement, and embracing the following described lands situated in Chaves County, New Mexico, to-wit:

Township 13 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M. Section 15: $E_{\frac{1}{2}}SE_{\frac{1}{4}}$, $SE_{\frac{1}{4}}NE_{\frac{1}{4}}$;

containing 120 acres, more or less, and embraced in that certain Oil and Gas
Lease issued by the United States of America, as lessor, and bearing Las Cruces
Serial Number 069184, whose lessee of record and entire working interest owner is
Whaley Co., Inc., herein sometimes called "Whaley", has not at the date hereof
been committed to said Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, Article 31 of said Agreement provides in part:

"Any oil or gas interest in the unitized formation in lands within the Unit Area not committed hereto prior to submission of this Agreement to the Commissioner and the Director for final approval may thereafter be committed hereto upon compliance with the applicable provisions of Article 13 hereof and for a period of six (6) months thereafter, on the same basis of participation as provided for in Article 13 by the owner or owners thereof subscribing or consenting in writing to this Agreement, if the interest is a working interest, by the owner of such interest subscribing also to the Unit Operating Agreement.

"It is understood and agreed, however, that after six (6) months from the effective date hereof, the right of subsequent joinder as provided in this section shall be subject to such requirements or approvals and on such basis as may be agreed upon by ninety (90%) percent of the Working Interest Owners. Such joinder by a Working Interest Owner must be evidenced by his execution or ratification of this Unit Agreement and the Unit Operating Agreement subsequent joinders to this Agreement, as to tracts within the Unit Area, shall be effective as of the first day of the month following the approval thereof by the Commissioner and the Director."
