Attached for your files are photo copies of Unit Agreement and Unit Operating Agreement dated July 1, 1959, covering the captioned Unit. In the event you need any additional information in connection with subject Unit, please advise and we will attempt to furnish same.

For your information, we have been advised that the Washington, D. C. Office of the U. S. Geological Survey will grant final approval of this Unit on or before December 21, 1959.

Pursuant to the terms of the Farmout Contract between Pan American and Pubco Petroleum Corporation, Pan American must commence a Dakota test well in the NW/4 of Section 36, T-30-N, R-16-W (covered by State of New Mexico Lease E-8343), within thirty (30) days from date of final approval of the Unit. Section 9 of the Unit Agreement provides that if the well location is upon State lands, the location "shall be approved by the Commission and the Commissioner". We, therefore, request your immediate advice as to the procedure necessary to obtain approval by the Oil Conservation Commission of the above-described drilling location. Your early reply will be sincerely appreciated.
