CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL

There having been presented to the undersigned Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico for examination, the attached Agreement for the development and operation of acreage which is described within the attached Agreement, dated May 27, 1963, which has been executed or is to be executed by parties owning and holding oil and gas leases and royalty interests in and under the property described, and upon examination of said Agreement, the Commissioner finds:

- (a) That such agreement will tend to promote the conservation of oil and gas and the better utilization of reservoir energy in said area.
- (b) That under the proposed agreement the State of New Mexico will receive its fair share of the recoverable oil or gas in place under its lands in the area.
- (c) That each beneficiary Institution of the State of New Mexico will receive its fair and equitable share of the recoverable oil and gas under its lands within the area.
- (d) That such agreement is in other respects for the best interests of the state, with respect to state lands.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me under Sections 7-11-39, 7-11-40, 7-11-41, 7-11-47, 7-11-48, New Mexico Statutes Annotated 1953 Compilation, I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico, for the purpose of more properly conserving the oil and gas resources of the State, do hereby consent to and approve the said Agreement, and any leases embracing lands of the State of New Mexico within the area shall be and the same are hereby amended to conform with the terms thereof, and shall remain in full force and effect according to the terms and conditions of said Agreement. This approval is subject to all of the provisions of the aforesaid statutes.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on
June 26, 1963, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Daniel S. Butler,
Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New
Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance
with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 9th day of July, 1963, the Commission,
a quorum being present, having considered the application, the
evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner,
Daniel S. Butler, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by
law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject
matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Jake L. Hansen, seeks approval of
the Southeast Hell Lake Unit Agreement covering 9,597.10 acres,
more or less, of State, Federal and Fee lands in Townships 24
and 25 South, Ranges 34 and 35 East, NMM, Lea County, New
Mexico.

(3) That approval of the proposed Southeast Hell Lake Unit
Agreement will in principle tend to promote the conservation of
oil and gas and the prevention of waste.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the Southeast Hell Lake Unit Agreement is hereby
approved.

(2) That the plan under which the unit area shall be oper-
ated shall be embraced in the form of a unit agreement for the

development and operation of the Southeast Bell Lake Unit Area, and such plan shall be known as the Southeast Bell Lake Unit Agreement Plan.

(3) That the Southeast Bell Lake Unit Agreement Plan is hereby approved in principle as a proper conservation measure; provided, however, that notwithstanding any of the provisions contained in said unit agreement, this approval shall not be considered as waiving or relinquishing, in any manner, any right, duty, or obligation which is now, or may hereafter be, vested in the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico by law relative to the supervision and control of operations for the exploration and development of any lands committed to the Southeast Bell Lake Unit, or relative to the production of oil or gas therefrom.

(4) (a) That the unit area shall be:

containing 9,557.10 acres, more or less.

(b) That the unit area may be enlarged or contracted as provided in said plan; provided, however, that administrative approval for expansion or contraction of the unit area must also be obtained from the Secretary-Director of the commission.

(5) That the unit operator shall file with the Commission an executed original or certified counterpart of the Southeast Bell Lake Unit Agreement within 30 days after the effective date thereof. In the event of subsequent joinder by any party or expansion or contraction of the unit area, the unit operator shall file with the commission within 10 days thereafter counterparts of the unit agreement reflecting the subscription of those interests having joined or ratified.

(6) That this order shall become effective upon the approval of said unit agreement by the Department of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico and the Director of the United States Geological Survey, and shall become void and of no effect upon the termination of said unit agreement. The said unit operator shall notify the Commission immediately in writing of such termination.

(7) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
