There having been presented to the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico, an application for termination of the Unit Agreement for the development and operation of the North White City Unit Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. The North White City Unit Agreement is dated March 30, 1968, and was approved by the Commissioner of Public Lands as of May 14, 1968.

The application for termination has been executed by the working interests that were committed to the North White City Unit Agreement, and such constitute in the aggregate seventy-five (75%) percent, or more, on an acreage basis of the working interests so committed and that provision is made for the termination of the Unit Agreement under Section 20 thereof by the owners of such a percentage of the working interests so committed to the North White City Unit Agreement.
