Dear Sir:

Reference is made to Commission Order No. R-3628, recently entered in Case No. 3939, approving the Anadarko Far West Loco Hills Water-flood Project.

Injection is to be through the ten authorized water injection wells, each of which shall be equipped with a string of plastic-coated tubing set in a packer. The packers shall be set as near to the uppermost open perforation as is practicable or in the case of open-hole completions, as near to the casing-shoe as is practicable.

As to allowable, our calculations indicate that when all of the authorized injection wells have been placed on active injection, the maximum allowable which this project will be eligible to receive under the provisions of Rule 701-E-3 is 938 barrels per day when the Southeast New Mexico normal unit allowable is 42 barrels per day or less. This figure is based upon wells which are now on production or which are included in the program outlined on Exhibit VII for conversion of wells to water injection and the drilling and recompletion of certain wells for production.

Please report any error in this calculated maximum allowable immediately both to the Santa Fe office of the Commission and the appropriate district proration office.

In order that the allowable assigned to the project may be kept current, and in order that the operator may fully benefit from the allowable
