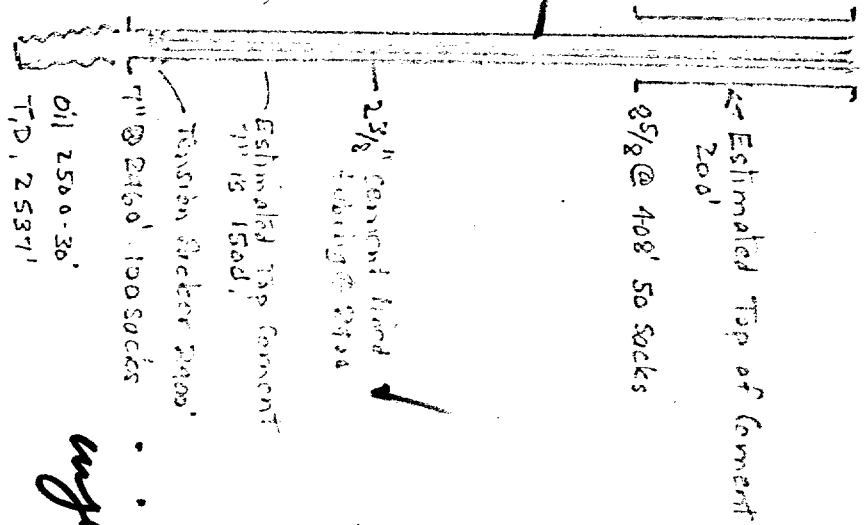

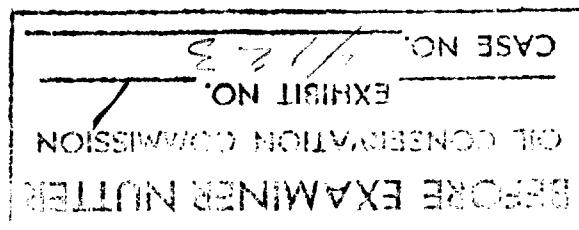




EXHIBIT "A"
