> SECOND ENLARGEMENT NORTH VACUUM ABO UNIT LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

### Gentlemen:

In accord with Section 4(a) of the North Vacuum Abo Unit Agreement Mobil, as Unit Operator, requests preliminary concurrence of the Commission to enlarge subject unit as outlined below. We are concurrently requesting preliminary approval from the Commissioner of Public Lands.

It is proposed the unit be enlarged to include the area shown on the attached map. The basis for expanding the unit is shown on the attached calculation sheet. The formula proposed for the expansion is based 14.5% on current production (first four months 1973), 14.5% primary reserves as of May 1, 1973, and 71% primary ultimate. Approximately 29% of total future reserves in the expanded unit are primary and 71% are fluid injection.

Working interest owners owning 94+% of the committed working interest in the unit have approved the proposed enlargement.

Following preliminary approval of the Commission and Commissioner, a notice of proposed expansion describing the contemplated changes in the boundaries of the Unit Area, the reasons therefor, and the proposed effective date (hopefully February 1, 1973) will be sent to the Commission, the Commissioner and to each working interest owner, lessee and lessor whose interests are affected, advising that 30 days will be allowed for submission to the Unit Operator of any objections. Upon expiration of the 30-day period, we will file with the Commission and Commissioner evidence of mailing of the notice of expansion and a copy of any objections thereto which have been filed with the Unit Operator, together with an application for approval of such expansion and with appropriate joinders. We request your early approval.



NOTICE OF PROPOSED SECOND EXPANSION NORTH VACUUM ABO UNIT LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

### Gentlemen:

Having obtained the approval of more than three working interest owners, owning in excess of 90% of the committed working interest; and having obtained the preliminary concurrence of the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico, and the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, Mobil Oil Corporation, Unit Operator, does hereby give notice of the proposed North Vacuum Abo Unit expansion, to be made effective on November 1, 1976 at 7:00 a.m.

The unit boundary will be changed to include Texaco's New Mexico State "W" lease, described as the SE/4 Section 13, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico, shown as Tract 18 on the attached Exhibit "A"; and Shell's State "VH" lease, described as the SW/4 Section 10, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico, shown as Tract 19 on the attached Exhibit "A". Tract 18 will have a unit participation of 1.83002% and Tract 19 will have a unit participation of 1.58749%.

The Texaco Tract 18, to be added, was included in the original study area but Texaco did not elect to commit the lease to the original unit. Well No. 4 on this lease was drilled after the original parameters were prepared. The Shell Tract 19, to be added, was not included in the original study area because it was not developed for Abo production at that time.

The inventory of equipment and investment adjustments will be handled in the same manner as they were when the unit first became effective. See Article 10.2 of the Unit Operating Agreement.

Shell and Texaco will be required to pay their proportionate part of preunitization expense and secondary recovery investment since the effective date of the unit. There will be no retreactive adjustment of production of unitized substances, nor operating expenses.

Thirty days following the date of this letter will be allowed for submission to Mobil, Unit Operator, of any written objections to the proposed enlargement, following which Mobil will request final approval of the unit enlargement from the Commissioner and the Commission.

Having obtained the approval of more than three working interest owners, owning in excess of 90% of the committed working interest; and having obtained the preliminary concurrence of the Commissioner of Public Lands, State of New Mexico, and the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, Mobil Oil Corporation, Unit Operator, does hereby give notice of the proposed North Vacuum Abo Unit expansion, to be made effective on August 1, 1973 at 7:00 a.m.

The unit boundary will be changed to include Gulf's Lea "FE" State lease and Pennzoil's Bridges State lease, encompassing the entire N/2 of Section 11, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The two leases are shown as Tracts 1 and 17 on the attached revised unit area map. Tract 1 will be given a unit participation of 1.08482%, and Tract 17, 5.15519%.

The area to be added to the unit was in the original study area, but Tract I did not qualify because, without Tract 17, it was not contiguous with any part of the unit area. Tract 17 was not committed to the unit because Well #7 was drilled after the parameter period for current production was established, and Gulf did not agree with the net pore volume assigned to the tract. After

Well #7 was drilled and evaluated, it was agreed that the net pore volume assigned the tract was not accurate and therefore the primary ultimate was substituted for the net pore volume for this tract. With this change, Gulf has agreed to commit its lease to the unit.

The inventory of equipment and investment adjustments will be handled in the same manner as they were when the unit first became effective. See Article 10.2 of the Unit Operating Agreement.

Gulf and Pennzoil will be required to pay their proportionate part of pre-unitization expense and secondary recovery investment since the effective date of the unit. There will be no retroactive adjustment of production of unitized substances, nor operating expenses.

Thirty days following the date of this letter will be allowed for submission to Mobil, Unit Operator, of any written objections to the proposed enlargement, following which Mobil will request final approval to unit enlargement.
