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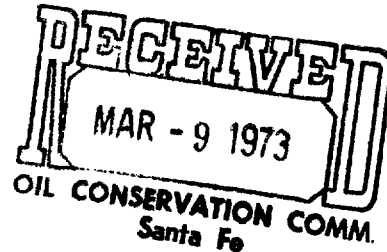

RE: SHENANDOAH APPLICATIONS

Confirming our telephone conversation of yesterday, I am enclosing herewith the following Applications filed on behalf of Shenandoah Oil Corporation:

1. Application for Approval of Robinson Jackson Unit Agreement covering 1160 acres of federal land in Eddy County. The U.S.G.S. has tentatively approved the Unit and Shenandoah is the sole working interest owner. As soon as the Unit has been approved by both your office and the U.S.G.S., the Operator will be ready to commence operations as the necessary royalty owner ratifications have been obtained.
2. Application for Approval of Robinson Jackson Waterflood Project for the injection of water into sixteen wells located in Sections 27, 34 and 35, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, which is in connection with the Unit Agreement. We have requested the U.S.G.S. approval of the waterflood project as evidenced by a copy of our letter addressed to the Artesia Office of the U.S.G.S. which is also enclosed. As indicated in our Application, we will furnish such logs as are available at the time of the hearing.

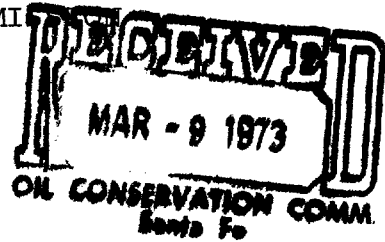

APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF ROBINSON-JACKSON UNIT AGREEMENT

Comes now the Applicant, Shenandoah Oil Corporation, and hereby makes application for approval of the Robinson-Jackson Unit Agreement, and states:

1. Applicant hereby requests that the Commission approve the Robinson-Jackson Unit Agreement covering 1160 acres, more or less, of federal lands in Eddy County, New Mexico, described as follows:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, N.M.P.M.

Section 27: $E\frac{1}{2}$, $E\frac{1}{2}W\frac{1}{2}$

Section 34: $NE\frac{1}{4}$, $NE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$, $NE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$

Section 35: $N\frac{1}{2}$, $N\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}$, $NE\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}$

2. That the Applicant, Shenandoah Oil Corporation, is the sole working interest owner and Unit Operator of the Unit Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto.

3. That the Applicant will file an executed counterpart of the Unit Agreement after it has been approved by the Oil and Gas Supervisor of the United States Geological Survey.

4. That the proposed Unit Agreement will promote the prevention of waste and will protect the correlative rights within the Unit Area.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the Commission to set this matter down for hearing before an examiner at an early date, publish


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notice as required by law, and, after hearing, issue its Order approving the Robinson-Jackson Unit Agreement.
