Gentlemen:

All copies of your applications of November 7, 1978 and March 6, 1979, for approval of the tenth, eleventh, and twelfth Delaware participating area revisions of the Old Indian Draw unit, Eddy County, New Mexico, are returned herewith, unapproved, for the following reasons:

- 1. No production history or reserve-economic analysis for the control wells are furnished to justify the commercial determination of such wells pursuant to the criteria of section 9 of the unit agreement. The only information furnished by your application is the initial potential of the wells involved which were completed in May, June, and July 1977. We need decline curve extrapolations and discounted net worth of the recoverable reserves related to drilling costs and operating expense to justify this determination.
- 2. No geological report is submitted except for a structure map which seems to indicate that unit well No. 23, one of the wells on which the tenth revision is based, is outside the limits of the line upon which the structural elevation lines close. This map needs some explanation and should be supported by a narrative type geological report.

Automatic elimination became effective for the Old Indian Draw unit agreement on December 15, 1978 and you were required by section 2(e) thereof to describe the area so eliminated within 90 days following such effective date to the satisfaction of the Supervisor. Inasmuch as the delineation of the final participating area must be established before automatic elimination can be finalized, you are hereby requested to submit the completed applications for approval of the tenth, eleventh, and twelfth Delaware participating area revisions with the supporting information described by items 1 and 2 above, within 60 days of the date of this letter.

Gentlemen:

Please reference our previous letter, dated November 7, 1978, File: CGF(10)-766-LF, in which we applied for expansions to the Delaware Participating Area of the Old Indian Draw Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico. At the request of the USGS, we have revised our application as follows:

Recommendation of the Tenth Expansion is based on the completion of two wells:



- (a) Well No. 19 in NE/4 SW/4 of Section 7 on May 2, 1977, pumping 151 barrels of oil and 20 barrels of water per day.
- (b) Well No. 23 in Lot 7 of Section 7 completed on May 29, 1977, pumping 19 barrels of oil and 19 barrels of water per day.

Recommendation of the Eleventh Expansion is based on the completion of three wells:

- (a) Well No. 21 in SW/4 SE/4 of Section 7 completed on June 13, 1977, pumping 104 barrels of oil and 14 barrels of water per day.
- (b) Well No. 24 in NW/4 SE/4 of Section 7 completed on June 30, 1977, pumping 80 barrels of oil and 16 barrels of water per day.
- (c) Well No. 22, in Lot 10 of Section 18, on June 19, 1977, pumping 44 barrels of oil and 0 barrels of water per day.

Recommendation of the Twelfth Expansion is based on the completion of Well No. 35 in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 7, on July 26, 1977, pumping 34 barrels of oil and 30 barrels of water per day.

In addition, we have attached revised participating schedules for each expansion, a map which graphically portrays each expansion, and, at the request of the USGS, a structure map of the unit. Your favorable consideration is respectfully requested.


