## APPLICATION

COMES NOW CITIES SERVICE OIL COMPANY and applies to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for approval of a unit agreement in Eddy County, New Mexico and in support thereof would show the Commission:

- 1. Applicant has formed a unit composed entirely of State of New Mexico acreage consisting of all of Sections 28, 29, 32, and 33 in Township 23 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, which is sufficient to give operator effective control of producing formations.
- 2. Applicant is designated as operator of the proposed unit and desired to drill a well located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line in Section 32, T23S, R25E, N.M.P.M., to test the Morrow at an anticipated depth of 11,200 feet.
- 3. The said unit agreement has been approved by sufficient owners of interests to assure its ultimate effectiveness.

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4. The granting of this application will result in the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant respectfully requests this matter be set for hearing before the Commission's duly appointed Examiner and that upon hearing, an order be entered approving the Unit Agreement.
