to the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico for
approval of a unit agreement in Eddy County, New Mexico
and in support thereof would show the Commission:

1. Applicant has formed a unit composed entirely
of State of New Mexico acreage consisting of all of
Sections 28, 29, 32, and 33 in Township 23 South, Range
25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, which is
sufficient to give operator effective control of produc-
ing formations.

2. Applicant is designated as operator of the pro-
posed unit and desired to drill a well located 1980 feet
from the North line and 660 feet from the East line in
Section 32, T23S, R25E, N.M.P.M., to test the Morrow at
an anticipated depth of 11,200 feet.

3. The said unit agreement has been approved by
sufficient owners of interests to assure its ultimate
effectiveness.
