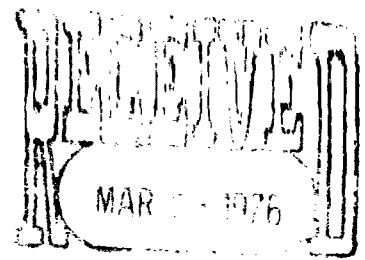
We are writing this letter on behalf of our client, Exxon Corporation, who is the Applicant for the above prepared Unit to be located in Lea County, New Mexico.

3. General Nature of Order Sought: Applicant seeks an Order to approve the Fairview Mills Unit Area embracing the foregoing lands.

4. Other Matters to be Noted in Connection with the Order Sought: Exxon Corporation is owner of certain interests in the above described lands and Exxon Corporation is the Applicant in connection with the Order sought. Exxon Corporation, however, will not be the Operator of the proposed Unit. Exxon Corporation presents this application at this time in order to expedite the consideration of the foregoing for approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. Time is of the essence in this matter because certain of the leases in the proposed Unit Area have primary terms which are to expire soon. It is anticipated that the identity of the Operator for the Fairview Mills Unit will be determined before the date of hearing for this matter. Lands embraced within the Unit Area include 3,520 acres of federal lands and 320 acres of fee lands. For the Commission's information, we transmit herewith a copy of a plat, labeled Exhibit "A", more particularly identifying the lands embraced within the proposed Unit Area for the Fairview Mills Unit. As of the date of the submission of this written application, copies of the proposed Unit Agreement for the Fairview Mills Unit are not available to the Applicant. As soon as copies of such a Unit Agreement become available, Applicant will arrange transmittal of copies of that Unit Agreement to the Commission for its information and further use in this case.

I trust that the foregoing will provide all the necessary information and data to complete the formal written application for hearing on March 31, 1976. However, if any additional information is needed, please advise immediately.

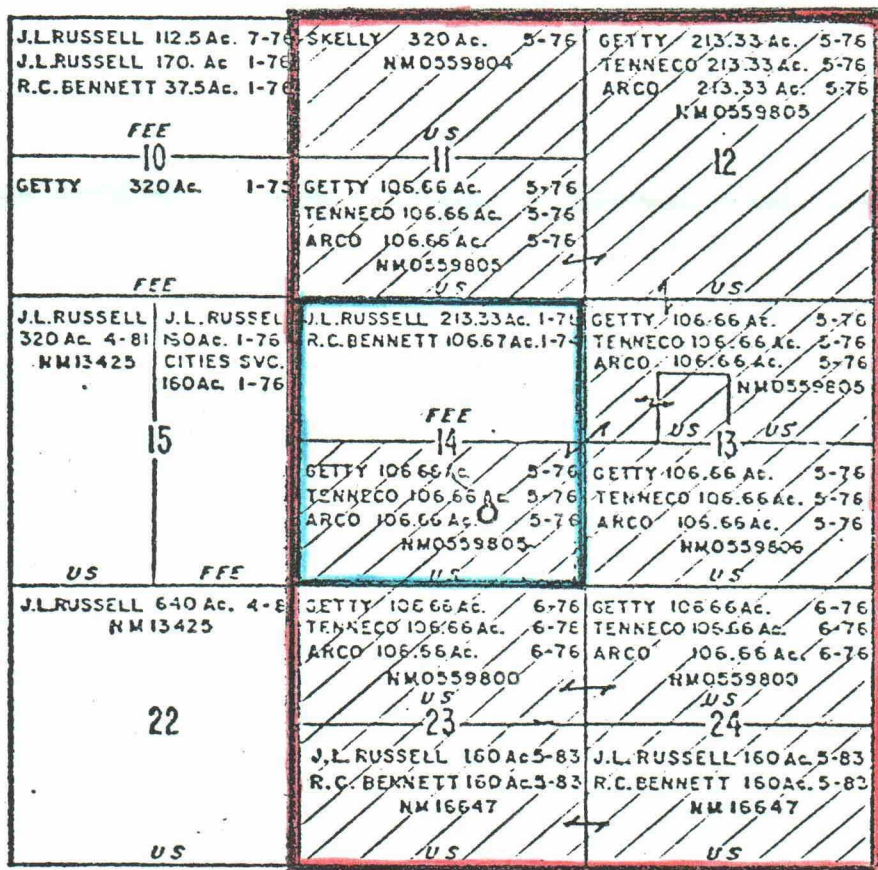
