Gentlemen:

This letter is in regard to the development program of the above named unit.

Summarizing the activities of 1989, there was no new wells drilled due to the low price of crude oil as well as the decline in production.

At this writing the unit has 27 producers, 5 temporary abandon wells and 1 injection well. There is enclosed a platt of West Square Lake Unit and all wells shown therein are part of the unit. All wells are producing from the Graburg - San Andres formation found at approximately 3150 feet to 3350 feet.

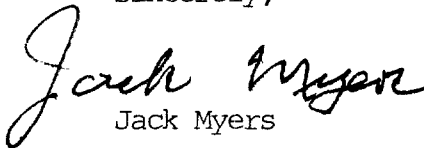
There is further enclosed a copy of the updated decline curve on the unit from January 1979 through December 1989. You can readily see the effect of the new wells drilled on this curve.

There is further enclosed tract production performance as well as water production. Should you require more detail breakdown, a copy of the C-115's can be furnished.

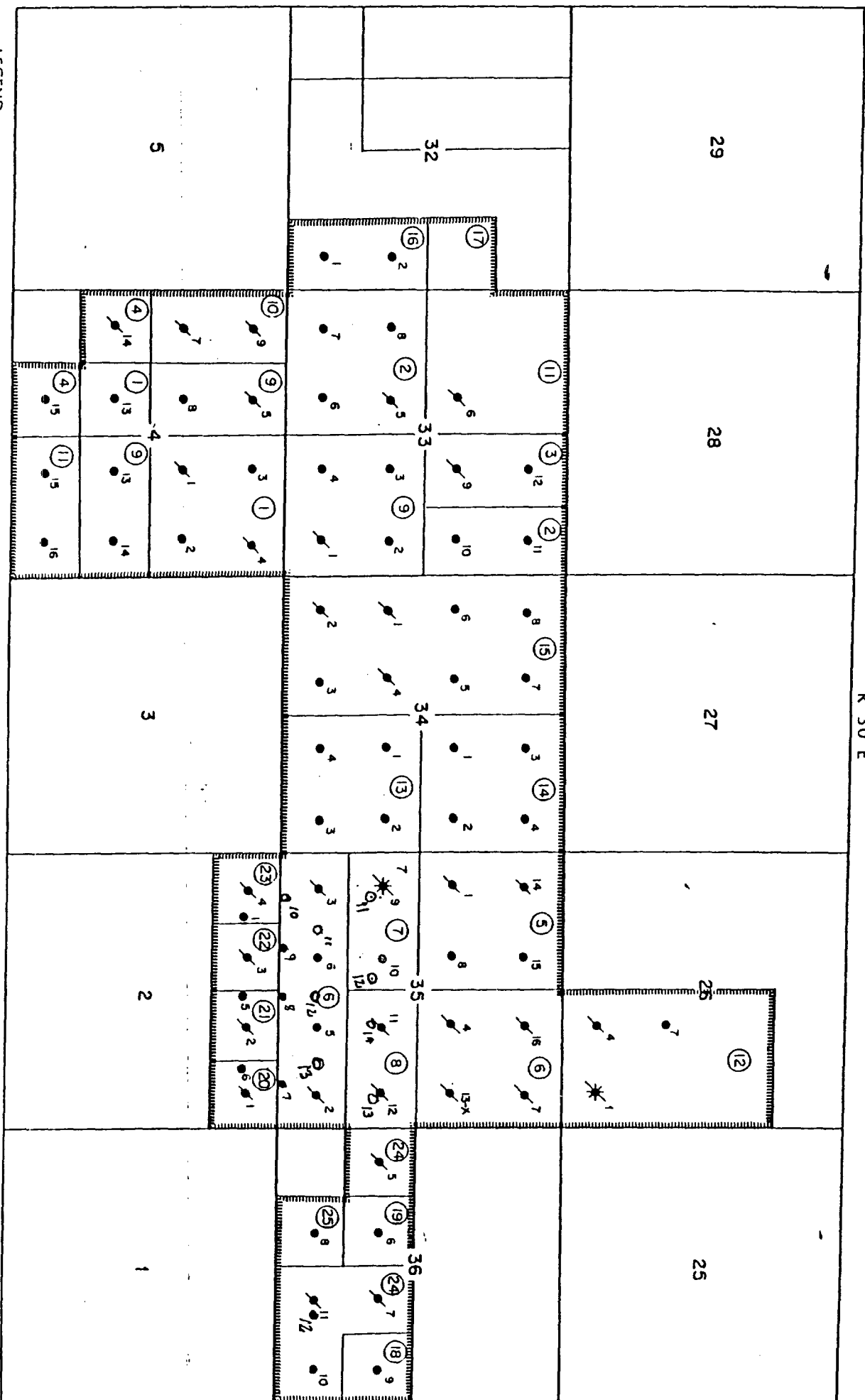
As to development in 1990 it is possible that one or maybe two new wells will be drilled this year. The price of oil and the performance of existing wells will govern this decision.

(h) "Unitized Formation" means that interval underlying the Unit Area which is productive of Unitized Substances having been heretofore found to occur in the Newmont Oil Company Etz "C" No. 1 Well (located in Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico) at an indicated depth of from 2,818 feet to 3,150 feet, as recorded on the Borehole Compensated Sonic Gamma log measured from a kelley bushing elevation of 3,740 feet above sea level.

(i) "Unitized Substances" means all oil and gas, gaseous substances, sulphur contained in gas, condensate, distillate and all associated and constituent liquid or liquefiable hydrocarbons within or produced from the Unitized Formation.

(j) "Unit Participation" of a Working Interest Owner as used herein shall mean the sum of the Tract Participations of such Working Interest Owner, as shown by tracts for each such Working Interest Owner in Exhibit "B" to this Agreement.

(k) "Working Interest" is defined as the right to search for, produce and acquire Unitized Substances whether held as an incident of ownership of mineral fee simple title, under an oil and gas lease, or otherwise held.

(l) "Working Interest Owner" is defined as and shall mean any Party hereto owning a Working Interest, including a carried Working Interest Owner, holding an interest in Unitized Substances by virtue of a lease, operating agreement, fee title or otherwise, which interest is chargeable with and obligated to pay or bear, either in cash or out of production, or otherwise, all or a portion of the cost of drilling, developing and producing the Unitized Substances and operation hereunder.

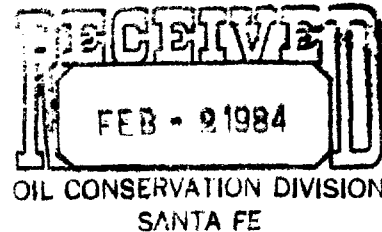
