TAYLOR: The application of 5 Santa Fe Exploration Company for a unit agreement, Lea Coun-6 ty, New Mexico. 7 MR. PADILLA: Mr. Examiner, Er-8 nest L. Padilla, Santa Fe, New Mexico, for the applicant in this case. 10 have two witnesses to be 11 sworn. 12 MR. STOGNER: Are there any 13 other appearances in this matter? 14 Will the witnesses please stand 15 and be sworn. 16 17 (Witnesses sworn.) 18 19 STEVE L. SIMMONS, 20 21 being called as a witness and being duly sworn upon his 22 oath, testified as follopws, to-wit:

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BY MR. PADILLA:

Q Mr. Simmons, for the record would you please state your name, by whom you're employed, and in what capacity?

DIRECT EXAMINATION

A Steven L. Simmons. I'm employed by Santa Fe Exploration Company and I'm the Secretary-Treasurer.

Q What -- have you previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division and had your credentials accepted as a matter of record?

A No, I have not.

Q Would you please tell the examiner what your educational background is?

A I attended the University of Oklahoma and have a Bachelor's degree in business administration with a major in accounting.

I have four and a half years experience in the oil and gas industry; the last three of which are with Santa Fe Exploration Company.

Q What duties do you perform for Santa Fe Exploration other than --

A Well, it's a small company and I do a number of things, one of which is land work, some field work, some administrative and accounting.

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Q Are you familiar with the Airstrip Northwest Deep Unit Area?

A Yes, I am.

Q Have you put together the documents in connection with that unit agreement?

A Yes.

 $$\operatorname{MR.}$$ PADILLA: Mr. Examiner, we tender Mr. Simmons as an expert landman.

MR. STOGNER: Mr. Simmons is so qualified as a practical landman and an officer of the corporation -- company.

Mr. Simmons, please refer to what we have marked as Exhibit Number One and have you tell the Examiner what that is and what it contains.

A Exhibit Number One is the standard form unit agreement for the Airstrip Northwest Deep Unit, consisting of Section 20, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and it contains Exhibits A, which is the map of the acreage, and Exhibit B, which shows the working interest and royalty owners.

Q Looking at Exhibit A, would you explain to the Examiner what the unit consists of?

A The unit area consists of Section 20, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, and is made up of 320 acres of fee land and the east half of the section consists of

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two State leases, making a total of 640 acres.

Q Go on now to Exhibit B of the unit agreement and tell us what that is.

A Exhibit B shows the ownership, working interest and royalty, of the tracts as they're shown on Exhibit A, Tract 1 being the fee lease, the west half; Tract 2 being the State lease, 240 acres, LG-2869; and Tract 3 being the State Lease, V-687, consisting of 80 acres.

What percentage of the working interest

A One hundred percent.

Q How about the royalty interest?

A One hundred percent.

Q Let me show you what we have marked as Exhibit Number Two and have you identify that.

A Exhibit Number Two is the letter which gives the approval of the Director of the Oil and Gas Division of the Commissioner of the State of New Mexico, Commissioner of Public Lands' approval of the Airstrip Northwest Deep Unit Agreement.

Q Let me refer you to page two of the unit agreement and ask you why Manzano Oil Corporation is the operator under that unit agreement.

A At the time we filed the -- filed the ad-

1 vertisement for the unit agreement, Santa Fe Exploration 2 Company owned 100 percent of the working interest and subsequent to that time we have made an agreement with Manzano Oil Corporation and farmed out our interest to them. 5 You will retain some interest in the unit 6 area. 7 Yes, we have retained an override, which Α 8 is convertible to a working interest after payout. 9 Q The unit -- the designation of Manzano 10 Oil Corporation on page two merely means that 11 going to operate the unit. 12 Yes, it does. Α 13 Q Do you have anything further to add to 14 your testimony? 15 Α No, sir. 16 MR. PADILLA: Mr. Examiner, we 17 move the introduction of Exhibits One and Two. 18 MR. STOGNER: Exhibits One and 19 Two will be admitted into evidence. 20 MR. And we'll call PADILLA: 21 Marvin Gross, unless the Examiner has any questions of Mr. 22 Simmons. 23 MR. STOGNER: I have no ques-24 tions of Mr. Simmons at this time.

GROSS, 5 being called as a witness and being duly sworn upon his oath, testified as follows, to-wit: 7 8 DIRECT EXAMINATION 9 BY MR. PADILLA: 10 Gross, for the record would you Mr. 0 11 please state your full name and where you reside? 12 Marvin C. Gross, and I reside in Roswell, 13 New Mexico. I'm a consulting geologist representing Sant Fe 14 Exploration and Manzano Oil. 15 Mr. Gross, in connection with this --16 17 well, let me ask you first, have you previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division and had your creden-18 tials accepted as a geologist? 19 20 Yes, I have. 21 Are you familiar with the Airstrip Northwest Deep Unit Area? Α Yes. 23 And have you prepared certain exhibits 24 0 25 for introduction at this hearing today?

The Morrow cross section exhibit that is being presented today was originally prepared by Mr. Smith, a geologist that was employed by Santa Fe in 1983.

I have taken and revised the map since the well in Section 18 has been drilled, recontoured and updated it.

MR. PADILLA: Mr. Examiner, we tender Mr. Gross as an expert geologist.

MR. STOGNER: He is so qualified.

Q Mr. Gross, would you please refer to what we have marked as Exhibit Number Three and have you tell us what that is?

A Exhibit Three is a cross section of the Morrow section extending from the well in Section 9 of 18, 34, to a well in Section 4 of 19, 34.

It shows that in this area we have a deposition of a narrow sand channel and our idea is to, of course, be within this sand thickness, the thickest part of this channel and up dip to the well in 18, which was wet, and the well in 29, which was -- produced water.

And the structure map on the cross section indicates that we can get approximately 100 to 150 feet high to the well in Section 18; therefore, should produce gas.

Q Mr. Gross, is the Morrow formation the deepest formation to be tested with the initial well drilled in the unit?

A Yes, it is. The Morrow is our deepest horizon; however, there is several zones in the Bone Spring that we will test and there's approximately ten to twelve zones that have shows in the area and has produced in different wells --

Q Does --

A -- in the area.

Q The Airstrip Northwest Deep Unit will be an exploratory unit, is that correct?

A Yes, it will.

Q In your opinion would approval of the application be in the best interest of conservation and prevention of waste and protection of correlative rights?

A Yes, it would, and especially in the Bone Spring horizons. There are so many zones that have numerous shows but we don't know the reservoir qualities of them, and to me it would be economically feasible to have time to test your well before you drilled an offset to it, before you were forced to drill an offset, and the unit would allow us to develop the acreage in a prudent manner.

Q Mr. Gross, do you have anything further to add to your testimony?

11 1 A No. 2 PADILLA: Mr. Examiner, I MR. 3 the introduction of Exhibit Three and I pass the witness. 5 STOGNER: Exhibit Three MR. 6 will be admitted in evidence at this time. 7 I have no further questions 8 Mr. Gross. 9 Are there any other questions 10 of this witness? 11 If not, he may be excused. 12 Mr. Padilla, do you have any-13 thing further in Case 8681? 14 MR. PADILLA: Nothing further. 15 STOGNER: I've got one MR. 16 quick question for Mr. Simmons. 17 Is it my understanding that the 18 unit operator is Manzano and not Santa Fe Exploration, 19 Simmons? 20 MR. SIMMONS: Yes, sir. 21 MR. STOGNER: Why is it that 22 Santa Fe Exploration is the applicant today? 23 SIMMONS: The advertising, MR. 24 we advertised for the unit. 25 MR. STOGNER: And you work, you

1 and Mr. Gross both work for Santa Fe Exploration, is 2 correct? 3 Well, Mr. Gross MR. SIMMONS: also works for Manzano. 5 MR. GROSS: I'm an independent 6 consultant, sir. 7 MR. SIMMONS: The situation was 8 that I was the only one available to come up here and I knew more about it than -- or I put the unit together before we 10 farmed it out to Manzano and I just was trying to do them a 11 favor. 12 MR. STOGNER: Okay, so is Santa 13 Fe Exploration, I assume, is acting as an agent for Manzano, 14 is that correct? 15 MR. SIMMONS: Yes, exactly. 16 MR. STOGNER: Okay, and a work-17 ing interest owner in the unit. 18 MR. SIMMONS: Yes. 19 MR. STOGNER: Okay. Thank you, 20 Mr. Simmons. I have no further questions. 21 there anything further in 22 this case? 23 If not, this case will be taken 24 under advisement. 25
