Hendrix Corporation opposes the application to the extent that, as an adjoining working interest owner in the Blinebry-Tubb-Drinkard producing zone, it and other working interest owners will suffer drainage if a spacing change from 160 acres to 40 acres is permitted under the application. In addition, a change in allowable will have the effect of allowing Blinebry gas production in the pool to have a considerably higher allowable than wells outside the pool whose allowable on 160 acre spacing will be significantly lower.

John H. Hendrix Corporation takes the position that Blinebry gas allowable and spacing should remain unchanged.

APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Applicant appears in this case seeking an amendment of Division Order Nos. 8539 and 8541 to eliminate the gas well classification from the special pool rules governing the North Eunice Blinebry-Tubb-Drinkard Oil and Gas Pool and the redesignation of this pool as the North Eunice Blinebry-Tubb-Drinkard Pool. The amendments proposed to Division Order No. 8541, which approved a water flood for the North Drinkard Unit, will be to conform the water flood order to this change.

APPLICANT'S PROPOSED EVIDENCE

Applicant proposes to present three witnesses at the time of this hearing: Ms. Lisa Corder, a Petroleum Geologist; Mr. Bill Lancaster, a Petroleum Engineer; and Mr. Joe Ramey, a Petroleum Engineer.
