

1. Applicant has formed its Little Bear Unit, composed of State acreage consisting of the following lands:

638.72 acres, more or less, Section 18, Township 24 South,
Range 25 East, N.M.P.M.

2. Applicant is designated as operator of the proposed unit.

3. The Unit Agreement will be submitted to the Commissioner of Public Lands of New Mexico for preliminary approval prior to the June 25, 1992 hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division.

4. The said Unit Agreement has been approved by sufficient owners of interests to assure its ultimate effectiveness.

5. The said Unit is an exploratory unit being formed for the development of the acreage dedicated to it.

6. The unitized formation is the Delaware.

7. The granting of this application will result in the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Maralo, Inc., respectfully requests that this application be set for hearing before a duly appointed Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 25, 1992, and that, after notice and hearing as required by law, an order be entered approving the Unit Agreement.
