

Dear Mr. Catanach:

At the June 25, 1992 Examiner hearing in the above-referenced case, questions were raised concerning what vertical interval is included within the unitized area for the proposed Little Bear Unit. Although Maralo's initial test well on the unit is projected to the Delaware, the new State Form Unit Agreement declares that any and all formations in the unitized lands are unitized.

At your suggestion, representatives of Maralo discussed this matter with Pete Martinez at the New Mexico State Land Office. Mr. Martinez has advised that it is the intention of the Land Office that all formations from surface to basement be unitized regardless of the proposed depth of the initial test well. Mr. Martinez will confirm this interpretation for you if you desire to contact him.

Although Maralo intends to drill the initial unit well to the Delaware formation, it may at a later date desire to test deeper formations and, therefore, supports the Land Office's interpretation of the Agreement.

Accordingly, Maralo requests that the Oil Conservation Division's approval of this Unit Agreement recognizes that it unitizes all formations. To do otherwise would result in confusion about what formations the Agreement actually covers and could cause problems with future unit operations.




