Dear Mr. Bullock:

Our records reflect that Yates Petroleum Corporation is the operator of record for the Nonombre State Unit, Lea County, New Mexico.

Article 8, Drilling to Discovery provides that: The unit operator shall, within sixty (60) days after the effective date of this agreement, commence operations upon an adequate test well for oil and gas upon some part of the lands embraced within the unit area and shall drill said well with due diligence to a depth sufficient to attain the top of the Mississippian formation or to such a depth as unitized substances shall be discovered in paying quantities at a lesser depth or until it shall, in the opinion of unit operator, be determined that the further drilling of said well shall be unwarranted or impracticable; provided, however, that unit operator shall not, in any event, be required to drill said well to a depth in excess of 14,000 feet. Until a discovery of a deposit of unitized substances capable of being produced in paying quantities (to wit: quantities sufficient to repay the costs of drilling and producing operations with a reasonable profit) unit operator shall continue drilling diligently, one well at a time, allowing not more than six months between the completion of one well and the beginning of the next well, until a well capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities is completed to the satisfaction of the Commissioner or until it is reasonably proven to the satisfaction of the unit operator that the unitized land is incapable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities in the formation drilled hereunder.

Any well commenced prior to the effective date of this agreement upon the unit area and drilled to the depth provided herein for the drilling of an initial test well shall be considered as complying with the drilling requirements hereof with respect to the initial well. The Commissioner may modify the drilling requirements of this section by granting reasonable extensions of time when in his opinion such action is warranted. Upon failure to comply with the drilling provisions of this article the Commissioner may, after reasonable notice to the unit operator and each working interest owner, lessee and lessor at their last known address, declare this unit agreement terminated, and all rights, privileges and obligations granted and assumed by this unit agreement shall cease and terminate as of such date.

Our records reflect the following:

- The Nonombre State Unit Agreement was approved effective May 9, 2001.
- The Nonombre State Unit Well No. 1 was completed on December 10, 2001. A commercial well determination was never submitted for this well, therefore, the well is considered non-commercial and is to be produced on a lease basis.
- Pursuant to Article 8 of the unit agreement, the next exploratory well was due to be commenced on or before June 10, 2002.
- Pursuant to your telephone conversation with Pete Martinez, of this office on February 25, 2003, you advised this office that the "2nd unit well was never drilled and the unit is considered terminated."


Please be advised that the Nonombre State Unit Agreement has this date been terminated effective June 10, 2002 being the date the date the 2nd unit well was due to be commenced.

This office has received the unexecuted copy of the unit agreement, which you have submitted for the proposed Nonombre State Unit area, Lea County, New Mexico. This agreement meets the general requirements of the Commissioner of Public Lands, who has this date granted you preliminary approval as to form and content.

Preliminary approval shall not be construed to mean final approval of this agreement in any way and will not extend any short term leases, until final approval and an effective date have been given.

When submitting your agreement for final approval, please submit the following:

1. Application for final approval by the Commissioner setting forth the tracts that have been committed and the tracts that have not been committed.
2. A statement of record from Yates Petroleum Corporation that Devon Energy Production Company, L.P the lessee of record for tract number 6 was invited to join the unit.
3. Pursuant to Rule 1.045, applications for approval shall contain a statement of facts showing:
 - a. That such agreement will tend to promote the conservation of oil and gas and the better utilization of reservoir energy.
 - b. That under the proposed unit operation, the State of New Mexico will receive its fair share of the recoverable oil and gas in place under its lands in the proposed unit area.
 - c. That each beneficiary institution of the State of New Mexico will receive its fair and equitable share of the recoverable oil and gas under its lands within the unit area.
 - d. That such unit agreement is in other respects for the best interest of the trust.



5. Order of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. Our approval will be conditioned upon subsequent favorable approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
6. A copy of the Unit Operating Agreement (if applicable).
7. Copies of all the well records for the initial unit well.
8. The well name for the initial unit well should be changed to the Nonombre State Unit Well No. 1.
