

1. The proposed Unit Area consists of 1600 acres, more or less, of State, lands, situated in Chaves County, New Mexico. The horizontal limits of said unit are described as follows:

**Township 9 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M.**

Section 8:	All
Section 9:	S/2
Section 16:	All

2. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

3. The Applicant, Yates Petroleum Corporation, is designated as Unit Operator in said Unit Agreement and all oil and gas in the all formations are unitized.


4. The proposed Unit Area covers all, or substantially all, of the geological structures or anomaly involved.

5. Said Unit Agreement and the unitized operation and management of the Unit Area will be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste, and that it will protect the correlative rights of all parties concerned.
