Please docket 3 cases on our own motion for creation of non-standard proration units.

Our 3 cases include the following:

✓ Case #1

Case 88.52

Creation of 6 non-standard proration units for 160 acres deeper than the Mesaverde formation in the western boundary of Township 26 North, Range 2 West, Rio Arriba County, N.M. including sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31.

Case #2

Creation of 6 non-standard proration units for 320 acres deeper than the Mesaverde formation in the western boundary of Township 26 North, Range 2 West, Rio Arriba County, N.M. including sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Case #3

Creation of 7 non-standard proration units and exception to Gavilan-Mancos and Gavilan-Greenhorn-Graneros Dakota oil pool rules in the western boundary of Township 25 North, Range 2 West, Rio Arriba County, N.M. including sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Our request for non-standard proration units of 160 acres and 320 acres in formations deeper than the Mesaverde in that portion of the Township 26 North, Range 2 West, Rio Arriba County, N.M. is because of irregular sections.

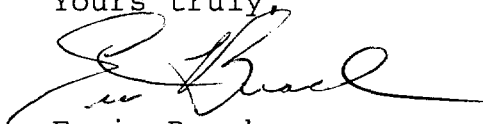
We feel that creation of the units are essential for reasonable development, thereby preventing waste and protecting correlative rights.

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Our request for non-standard proration units and asking for exception to special pool rules in the Gavilan-Mancos and Gavilan-Greenhorn-Graneros Dakota oil pools is necessary because of irregular sections in that portion of Township 25 North, Range 2 West, Rio Arriba County, N.M.

We feel that creation of the units and asking for special pool rules exception is essential to reasonable development, thereby preventing waste and protecting correlative rights.
