RE: Unorthodox oil well location, East Pearl Queen Unit Well No. 84; 165' FSL - 10' FWL (Unit M) Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 35 East, Pearl Queen Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Dear Ms. Atwater:

I am unable to administratively approve the subject unorthodox oil well location at this time. General Rule 104.F.I. and Ordering Paragraph No. (2) of Division Order No. R-2538, as amended, do not provide a provision for administrative review of producing wells drilled closer than 990 feet to the outer boundary of the East Pearl Queen Unit (see copies of Order Nos. R-2538, R-2538-A, and R-3737).

I have therefore set this filing to be heard before an Examiner at the next available hearing scheduled for April 18, 1990.
