




Dear Ms Nichols:

This letter is to advise you that Samedan Oil Corporation has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the force pooling of certain mineral interests in all formations to the base of the Ellenburger formation, in and under the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 26, Township 23 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. Samedan Oil Corporation proposes to dedicate the referenced pooled unit to its Hunt Well No. 1 to be drilled at an unorthodox location 1050 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of Section 26, to a depth of approximately 9,500 feet, more or less, to test the Ellenburger formation.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on March 31, 1994. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be subject to pooling, or affected by this well location, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases have been requested by the Division (Memorandum 2-90) to file a Prehearing Statement substantially in the form prescribed by the Division. Prehearing statements should be filed by 4:00 o'clock p.m. on the Friday before a scheduled hearing.


