APPLICATION


KLABZUBA OIL AND GAS, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division for an order approving an unorthodox well location in the Devonian formation, and in support of this application states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 12 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico and proposes to drill its Waller 2-14 Well to the Devonian formation, at an unorthodox location 1511 feet from the South line and 1004 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 14.
2. Applicant seeks an exception to Rule 104 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Division to permit the drilling of this well at the above-described location.
3. The above-described 40-acre standard proration unit should be dedicated to the well.
4. Approval of this application will afford applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil and gas from the Devonian formation and will otherwise be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 14, 1994, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the Division enter its Order granting this application and providing such other relief as is proper.
