Dear Mr. Trautman:

Reference is made to your application dated March 8, 1994 for an unorthodox Blinebry gas well location in an existing non-standard 80-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool comprising the W/2 NE/4 of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order No. NSP-995, dated May 9, 1975, and has dedicated thereon the Rollon Brunson Well No. 4, located 2086 feet from the North line and 1874 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 10.

It is our understanding that the subject well in this application is currently a dually completed Tubb gas and Drinkard oil well; however, said well will be plugged back and completed as a single Blinebry gas well upon issuance of this order.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170 as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox Blinebry gas well location is hereby approved:

*Rollon Brunson Well No. 6  
536' FNL - 2104' FEL (Unit B) of said Section 10.  
APL No. 30-025-10161*

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Blinebry Gas production from the Rollon Brunson Well No. 6 with the Rollon Brunson Well No. 4. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from both wells in any proportion.

Division Administrative Order NSL-811, dated December 2, 1976, which <sup>previously</sup> approved the <sup>subject</sup> Rollon Brunson Well No. 4 as an unorthodox gas well location in the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool is hereby
