CASE 10009:

In the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Division (OCD) on its own motion to consider revisions to Division Order No. R-8170, as amended. The OCD on the recommendation of the Gas Proration Rules Committee seeks to amend the General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended. Such changes include provisions for two 6-month allocation periods beginning April and October (~~Rules 5, 12 and 15~~); three month classification periods, and for any other changes deemed adequate and necessary for said Gas Proration Rules at this time.

This case will be continued to the September 27, 1990 hearing. The Commission will accept written comments on the proposed changes, ^{prior to the continued hearing} and ~~will accept~~ ^{will have accepted} written comments at the hearing as well as sworn testimony and exhibit evidence and oral or written comments.
