



Gentlemen:

In accordance with the provisions of Division Order No. R-11771 entered on May 22, 2002, which order promulgated temporary special pool rules for the North Osudo-Devonian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, including provisions for 160-acre spacing units and designated well locations, the Oil Conservation Division is reopening Case No. 12815 in order that the operators in the North Osudo-Devonian Pool may appear and show cause why the temporary special rules for the pool should not be rescinded and the pool developed on standard 40-acre oil spacing.

This case will appear on the docket for the Examiner Hearing to be held on May 8, 2003. This hearing will be held in Porter Hall, 1220 S. St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico, at 8:15 a.m. A copy of the advertisement for the May 8 hearing is enclosed.
