We have received notification concerning the Resignation of Unit Operator and Designation of Successor Unit Operator for the above referenced unit.

We hereby approve the resignation of Chevron USA, Inc as the unit operator for the Lancaster Spring Unit and the designation of Pogo Oil & Gas Operating, Inc as the successor operator of this unit. In accordance with this approval, Pogo Oil & Gas Operating, Inc is now responsible for conducting all operations in compliance with the Lancaster Spring Unit Agreement effective January 10, 2018.

- 3. A list of active wells in the unit with their API numbers; and
- 4. Any additional information that may have relevance to our approval of the Plan.
