Dear Mr. Terry:

The OXY USA Inc. 2018 Plans of Development (POD) for both the West Bravo Dome (WBDU) and Bravo Dome Units (BDU) located in Harding, Union and Quay Counties, New Mexico are approved as of April 3, 2018. A POD is required to be filed yearly by the unit operator and not later than March 1 of each year. No extension of time will be granted unless an unavoidable delay where justified.

For the West Bravo Dome Unit, it is noteworthy that OXY took over the operation on Sept. 1 of 2017 and estimates that its 2018 average production will be around 40.5 mmscfp/d of CO2 from 74 producing wells. For the Bravo Dome Unit its 2017 average production was 210 mmscfp/d of CO2 from 571 producing wells. OXY's longer range plans (2019-2023) for both units is to continue to add rate capacity to meet CO2 demand by possibly drilling 5-10 wells per year in the WBDU and 10-20 wells per year in the BDU.

Neither of these units contain Tribal or allotted lands as they are Fee, State and Federal lands.
