Reference is made to your letter of July 10, 1962.

Approval of proposed operations and release of a bonding bond, which inspection is made to ascertain whether a production permit was clear up of location or details and leveling of pipe. Such an inspection was made July 12, 1962, of the well site of ... Co., Inc. It was found that work had been done and leveling around the site and that the mud logs have not been leveled. Until this condition has been corrected to the satisfaction of the land owner, logging operations cannot be approved nor the bond released.
