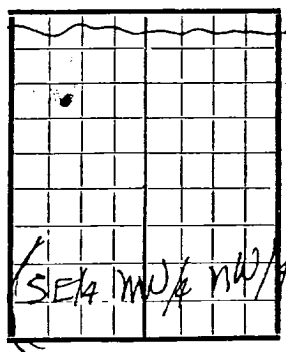

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: Will furnish same if advised amount & terms.

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 5000 feet.

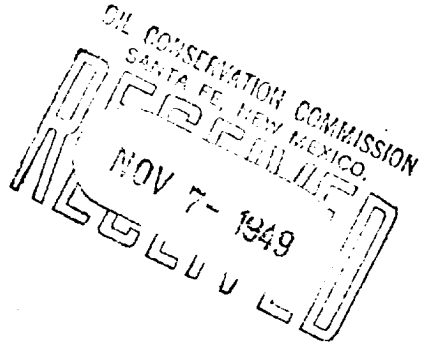

Dear Sir:

We have your letter of October 27th in regard to the notice of intention to drill covering a well location 990 N & W/L 2-23N-33E in the SE/4 NW/4 NW/4.

It was necessary for us to change this location to NE/4 NE/4 NW/4 Section 2-23N-33E.

We have written your office for additional forms on which to file a corrected application and upon receipt of same will file a notice of intention to drill at the new location. In the meantime, however, we have requested our insurance carrier to forward a \$5,000.00 bond covering the well at the new location. This should reach your office prior to the time we commence drilling.
