Dear Mr. Spar:

Review of the file for the above-referenced well indicates the following deficiencies that must be corrected within the next 15 days:

1. Form C-105 (enclosed) must be filed with the Division along with copies of all electrical and radio-activity logs, and a summary of all special tests conducted on the well.
2. Form C-103 (enclosed) must be filed detailing further testing to be performed or proposed procedures for plugging and abandonment according to OCD rules and regulations.

Within 45 days this well must be plugged in accordance with an approved program, or further testing must have begun and been witnessed by OCD personnel. If Forms C-103 and C-105 are not filed with this office within 15 days or if plugging operations are not commenced by mid-June, this matter will be turned over to our legal department and a forced plugging case will be set.
