Trinity Oilfield Services is submitting the following Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for the Federal 31 G #005 Accidental Discharge (AD). Trinity Oilfield Services was hired by Mewbourne Oil Co. to assist them in clean up of the AD. Mewbourne Oil Co. is the owner of the Federal 31 G #005.

On February 13, 2015 Mewbourne pumpers located the AD. NMOCD was notified on February 16, 2015 and a subsequent C-141 was submitted to the District 1 office on February 18, 2015. According to Mewbourne a high pressure caused the poly flow line to rupture. The result of the line failure was a 7 bbl. release. A 15' over spray into the

Mewbourne immediately took action to contain the AD using a vacuum truck and a backhoe. Mewbourne recovered 3 bbl. of produced fluid. The well was also shut in. The flow line was repaired and checked for integrity and additional leaks.

Trinity will begin excavating the contaminated soil in the effected area (EA) upon approval from NMOCD and BLM. Contaminated soil will be hauled to R360 in Lea Co., NM for disposal. All contaminated soil to the southeast will be removed and the EA to the south will have Micro-Blaze applied to it.

In regards to the sampling efforts, samples will be pulled from the entire EA. Contamination levels approved by NMOCD and BLM will be adhered to. Results will be reported to NMOCD and BLM before closure.
