**Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\***


An HOA switch was turned off at the water transfer pump which caused the tanks to run over and spill 220 bbls of produced water and 20 bbls of oil into the lined containment. The site was shut in for cleanup.

The spill was within a lined containment and was recovered via vacuum truck.
