Thank you for your 28-29Jun17 submissions of some of the work plans we asked for on 02Jun17 to recover NAPL effectively by use of more active remediation techniques. You have proposed up to three days of multiphase dual extraction (MPDE) efforts for most of the projects. You have also proposed soil vapor extraction (SVE) on another project to close the file on it.
