I have reviewed the files on the releases referenced above. The available information indicates LINN Energy has met the requirements of 19.15.29 NMAC and no further corrective action is required. You are notified these referenced remediation plans are closed.

I am unable to take action on the following closure requests for the reasons stated below.

- 1RP-3516 remediation has been requested to be deferred until tanks are to be abandoned
- 1RP-4631 additional vertical delineation requested by District I on 6/1/17
- 2RP-3138 no sampling or cleanup has been done, no work plans submitted
- 2RP-3168 no sampling or cleanup has been done, no work plans submitted
- 2RP-3282 no documents have been provided

If you have other information to provide to address these reasons, please advise us in that regard.
