- At least one sample must be collected from the point of release and analyzed for Benzene, BTEX, GRO+DRO, and TPH. If concentrations of the above-mentioned constituents are detected in the sample(s), confirmation sampling will need to be analyzed for all constituents listed in Table 1.
- Grab samples will be collected at a rate of no more than one sample per 500 square feet from the bottom of the excavation.
