Dear Ms. Beradelli:

According to Goo Yea Landfarm, Inc.'s (Goo Yea) permit conditions:

By January 10, 2000 Goo Yea must submit financial assurance in the amount of \$25,000.

By January 10, 2001 Goo Yea must submit financial assurance in the amount of \$37,615.

By January 10, 2002 Goo Yea must submit financial assurance in the amount of \$56,423.

By January 10, 2003 Goo Yea must submit financial assurance in the amount of \$75,230.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received the first scheduled amount of \$25,000. However the second scheduled amount of \$37,615 has not been submitted.

The scheduled increase was due January 10, 2001. Goo Yea Landfarm, Inc. must submit financial assurance in the amount of \$37,615. Failure to submit the required financial by May 18, 2001 will result in the requirement for the submittal of the complete financial assurance in the amount of \$75,230 and the issuance of a compliance order which may include the assessment of civil penalties pursuant to Section 70-2-31 NMSA 1978 as amended.
