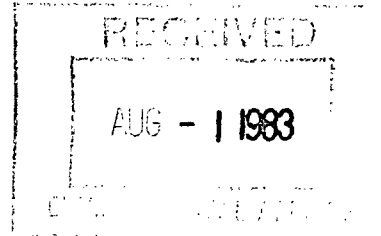

Hydrostatic Test Waters
in New Mexico

Dear Ms. Komator:

Northwest Pipeline Corporation is hereby granted a one year permit to dispose of hydrostatic test water from newly constructed pipelines. This permit is effective from the date of this letter and it is good for one year. Renewal of this permit will be granted upon request.

This permit is granted upon the following conditions:

- 1) That the procedures and reporting requirements as outlined in Northwest Pipeline Corporation's letter of April 21, 1983, will be followed.
- 2) No discharges of hydrostatic test water will be made into any lake, perennial stream or river, or their respective immediate tributaries that may be seasonal.
- 3) Only fresh water (10,000 ppm Total Dissolved Solids or less) shall be used for hydrostatic test water.
