Statewide Permit For Union Oil Company Of California For Disposal Of Hydrostatic Test Water

Union Oil Company of California, dba Unocal, requests a statewide permit from the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) for the disposal of fresh water used for testing pipelines constructed of new pipe.

Unocal plans to build any new pipeline system or well-ties with new pipe material. Before hydrostatically testing the lines, Unocal's pipeline contractor will purge these lines of any debris using soft pigs. The lines will be filled and tested with fresh water from an OJO ALAMO source well. Following the hydrostatic test, the lines will again be purged with soft pigs. Each test performed for Unocal will involve volumes less than 100,000 gallons. The tests are more likely to be no greater than 10,000 gallons each. The purged test water will then be used to hold down dust on lease roads. If the roads are already saturated, Unocal will have the water hauled to a state approved disposal facility.
