Dear Ms. Frost:

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has conducted a file review on the Hydrostatic Test Waters Permit HBP-NM-010 for the EOTT Energy Pipeline Limited Partnership (EOTT). Permit HBP-NM-010 **expired on December 14, 1998**. In addition, permit condition 5 (five) required that a report must be filed every 6 months summarizing the activities and that it shall contain the following information:

- A. Location of test – Section, Township, Range,
- B. Date of test,
- C. Volume of discharge and
- D. Source of test water.

EOTT failed to submit the 6 month reports for 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998. EOTT shall submit hydrostatic discharge 6 month reports for 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998 to the OCD **by January 2, 2000**.

If EOTT wishes to perform hydrostatic tests of 100,000 gallons or less on new pipe they must submit a new application to the OCD.
