The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has received your request, dated March 18, 1993, for authorization to discharge approximately 56,280 gallons of waste water generated from the hydrostatic test of the 3" laterals near Eunice, New Mexico.

This 3" line, as you stated in your request, is used to transport LPG, therefore this line is classified as a refined products pipeline. Based upon New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) delegation of authority, the New Mexico Environment Department (ED) has regulatory jurisdiction of refined product pipelines.

Please contact Ms. Marcy Leavitt of the ED Groundwater Bureau for authorization to discharge the hydrostatic test water.
