RE: Request for Extension - Temporary Hydrostatic Test Water Discharge Permit HI-093

Dear Mr. Martin:

Enterprise Products Operating, L.P., the operating company for GulfTerra Energy Partners L.P., respectfully requests a 90 day extension period for the Temporary Discharge Permit HI-093 (copy attached) issued by your office on January 26, 2005. Due to permitting delays and surface use restrictions, the discharge will not occur within the 120 day period authorized by the permit. No changes have been made to the original parameters previously submitted:

Project Name:	30" Trunk R End Of Loop to Navajo City Compressor Station
Line Length:	8,185 feet
Legal Description:	Portions of Sections 29, 30, 32, and 33, Township 30 North, Range 7 West, San Juan County, New Mexico
Land Owner:	Bureau of Land Management
Discharge Point:	Section 33, T30N, R7W. The discharge point will be selected to prevent discharge into any stream, arroyo, or other waterway.
Volume:	316,500 gallons
Pipe New or Used:	New
Discharge Velocity/Erosion Control:	The water will be discharged against a steel plate to dissipate the velocity. The water will then flow through staked straw bales to prevent erosion and/or silt deposition.

Dear Mr. Bays:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) has received your application, dated January 18, 2005 for a temporary permit to discharge water used to hydrostatically test new pipeline. The NMOCD reference for this permit is HI-093. This request is hereby approved with the following conditions and understandings:

1. The test water will be discharged in Section 33, Township 30 North, Range 7 West and the volume of the discharge will be 316,500 gallons.
2. The test water will be discharged at a controlled rate and into a structure that will prevent erosion.
3. The water has been used to hydrostatically test new pipe.
4. Potable water will be used.
5. The discharged fluids will not be allowed to migrate to a water of the state or a water of the U.S.
6. The Bureau of Land Management is the landowner at the point of discharge. The discharge will be maintained within the boundaries of their property.

Pursuant to WQCC Regulation 20 NMAC 6.2.3106.B, this approval will allow Enterprise Products Operating, LP (Enterprise) to discharge without an approved discharge permit for a period not to exceed 120 days commencing January 15, 2005. Discharge must cease within the 120-day period, or a formal discharge permit will be required. Pursuant to WQCC Regulation 20 NMAC 6.2.3114, an application fee (\$100) and a temporary permit fee (\$150) are due at time of application. These fees have not been received by the NMOCD and are due and payable upon receipt of this approval. If this site is to be used for more than one discharge, Enterprise must make a separate application for the additional discharge.

This approval does not relieve Enterprise of liability should their operation result in pollution of surface water, groundwater, or the environment, nor does it relieve Enterprise of its responsibility to comply with any other federal, state or local regulations.


