The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division has received and reviewed CH2M Hill's application, submitted on behalf of SFPP, for a hydrostatic test permit as shown above. This permit is hereby approved with the following conditions and understandings:

- 1. Total length of pipeline to be tested is 161.1 miles and is to be tested in six sections as described in the application.
- 2. All of the pipeline is new and has never contained petroleum products.
- 3. Water to be used in the testing is fresh water obtained from either the City of Deming or a private well located on Rex Kipp's property.
- 4. Total volume to be discharged will be 168,800 barrels.
- 5. Discharge locations are as described in the application.
- 6. Discharges will take place on or about October 18, 2005 and November 30, 2005.

The term of this permit is 120 days and will expire on February 18, 2005.
