**Duke Energy Field Services**  
**GW-185 Dagger Draw Gas Plant**  
**Eddy County, New Mexico**

Dear Ms. Char:

On February 17, 2000 Duke Energy Field Services received notification from the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) that the discharge plan GW-185 for the Dagger Draw Gas Plant located in the SW/4 of Section 25, Township 18 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, was to expire on April 12, 2000. A letter from Duke Energy Field Services, dated February 16, 2000 notified the OCD that an application for renewal of the GW-185 discharge plan would be submitted prior to the expiration date of April 12, 2000. To date no renewal application has been received by the Oil Conservation Division.

Duke Energy Field Services failure to comply with the requirements set forth in the notification is a violation of WQCC rules and regulations, specifically Section 3106.F. Duke Energy Field Services may be required to shut-in this facility and be subject to the civil penalties provided in Section 74-6-10.1 NMSA 1978 of the New Mexico Water Quality Act for failure to comply.

To avoid further enforcement action, you must submit the required renewal application no later than July 31, 2000. If you have any questions please contact Mr. W. Jack Ford at (505) 827-7156.

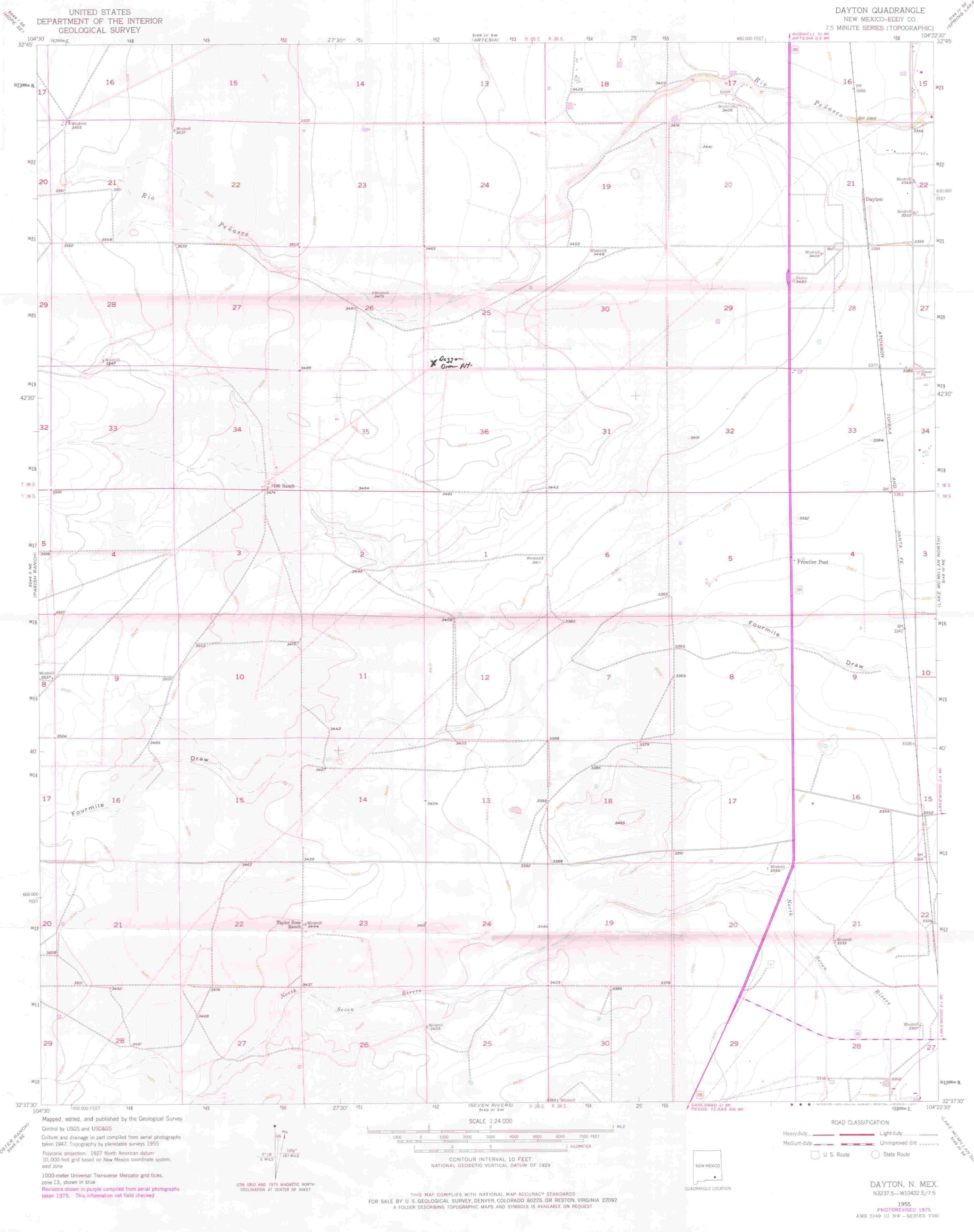
