Dear Mr. Savoie:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has reviewed Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line Company's (TNMPLC) November 24, 1997 "REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN, TEXAS - NEW MEXICO PIPELINE COMPANY, STEVANS PROPERTY, SEC 14-T21S-R37E, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO" which was received by the OCD on April 15, 1998. This document contains the results of TNMPLC's assessment of the extent of soil contamination resulting from a crude oil pipeline spill at TNMPLC's Monument No. 8 Site located in Unit O, Section 19, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The document also contains recommendations for remediation of soil areas with elevated levels of petroleum contaminants.

The OCD approves of the recommendations contained in the above referenced document with the following conditions:

1. TNMPLC will submit a final remediation report upon completion of the soil excavation, sampling and disposal actions. The report will be submitted to the OCD Santa Fe Office for approval with a copy provided to the OCD Hobbs District Office.
2. TNMPLC will notify the OCD at least 48 hours in advance of scheduled activities such that the OCD has the opportunity to witness the events and split samples.
